

Follow the LEADER: Intent to Award Posted

A procurement process that began in July 2004 is nearing an end. The Los Angeles County Department of Public Social Services (DPSS) issued an Intent to Award the Los Angeles Eligibility Automated Determination Evaluation and Reporting (LEADER) Replacement System to Accenture LLP. The LEADER System automates administration of welfare programs in LA County (CalWORKs, Food Stamps, Medi-Cal, CAPI, and General Relief), including eligibility determination, benefit calculation, case maintenance, and management/fiscal reports and controls. Proposals had been under evaluation since May 2008 with the threat of a two-year award delay due to the California budget crises. Contract negotiations will begin in September 2009.
