

## Pre-Bid Conference Held for CREST

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A non-mandatory pre-bid conference was held today for **Riverside County's** multi-million dollar property tax system. An RFP was released on June 1, 2009 for the project entitled County of Riverside Enterprise Solutions for Property Taxation, or **CREST**.

The purpose of the RFP will be the design, development and implementation of an Integrated Property Tax Management System (IPTMS). When fully implemented, the IPTMS will replace the existing legacy property tax systems.

The desired solution would:

- Meet all applicable property tax legal mandates
- Improve public service
- Improve access to property tax information
- Afford seamless implementation of new technology applications
- Improve effectiveness in property tax administration
- Improve efficiency
- Improve integration of processes throughout the three stakeholder departments
- Re-design / re-engineer departmental business processes

Final questions are due by 5:00 PM local time on July 31, 2009. The moderator stated that despite the request of the vendor community, at this time, proposals remain due by 1:30 local time on September 1, 2009. The moderator also stated that while the County would like to get this project awarded as soon as possible after proposals have been received, it is prepared that evaluations may be completed in as little as 30 days, to as many as 180 days.
